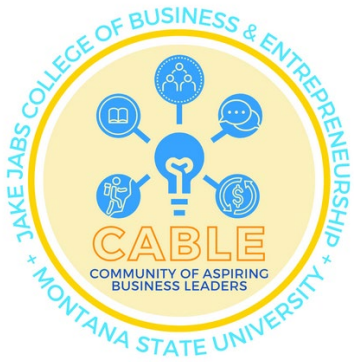

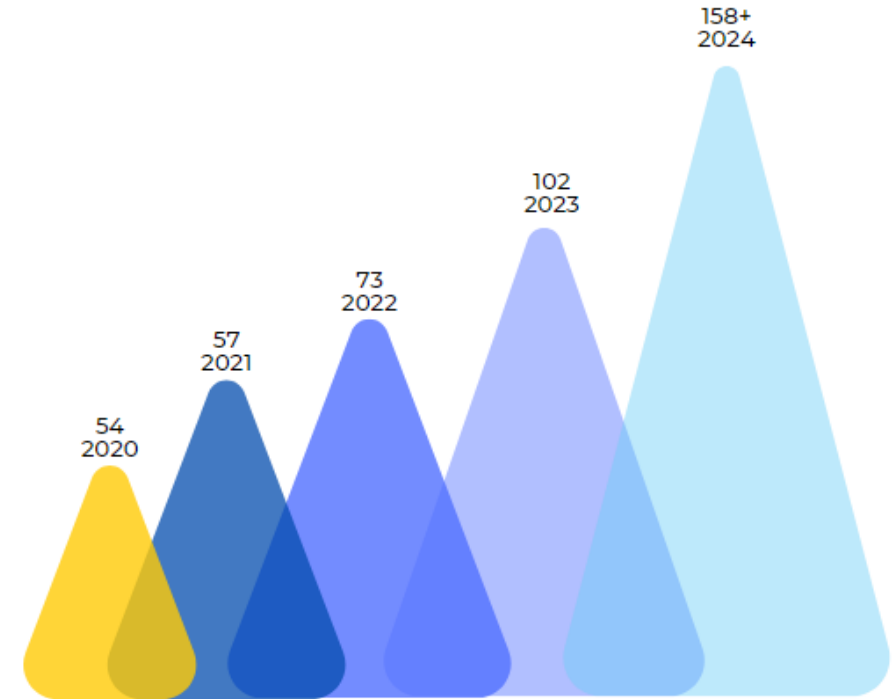

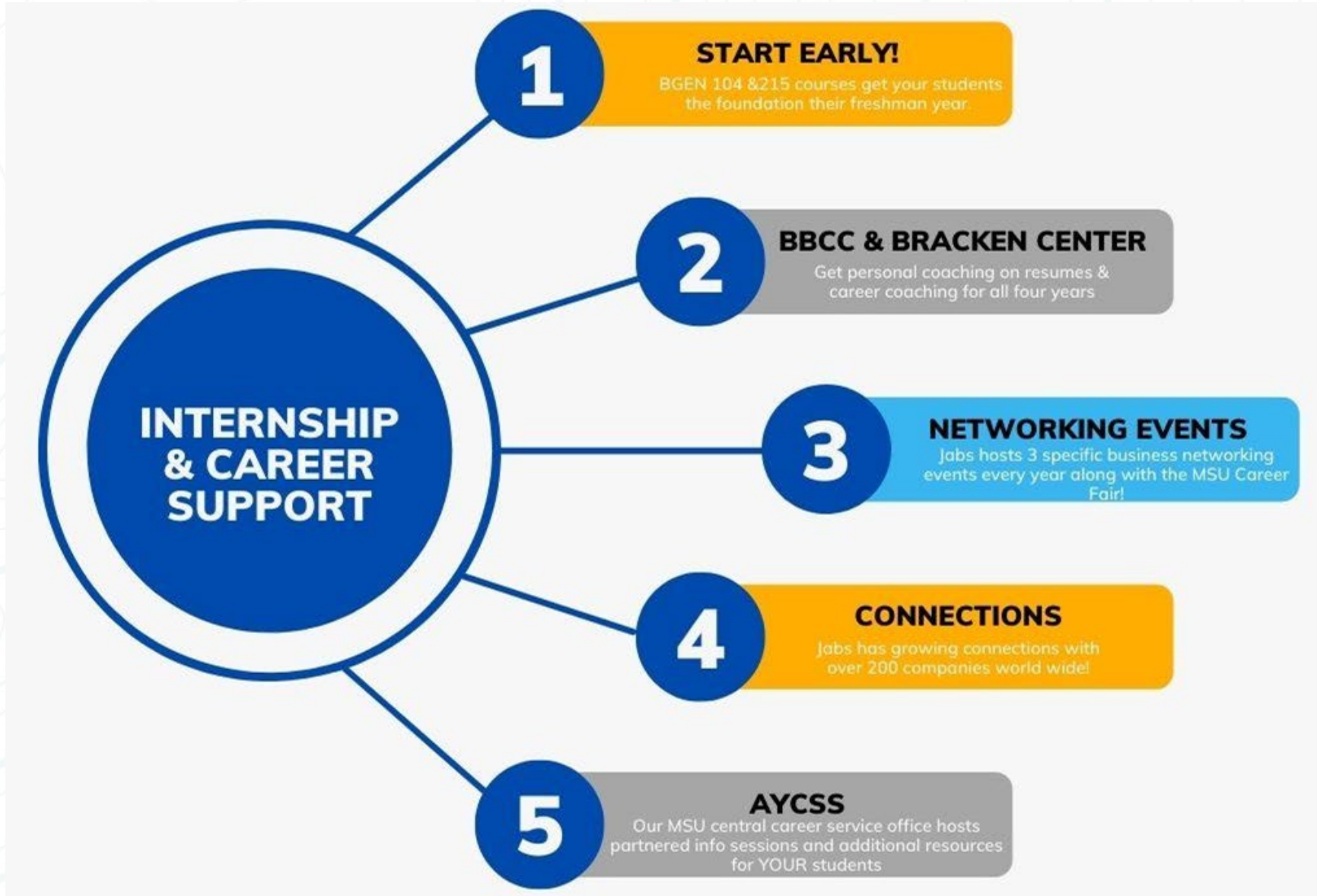
Internships for Credit

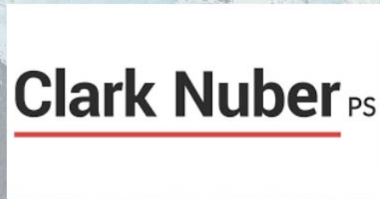

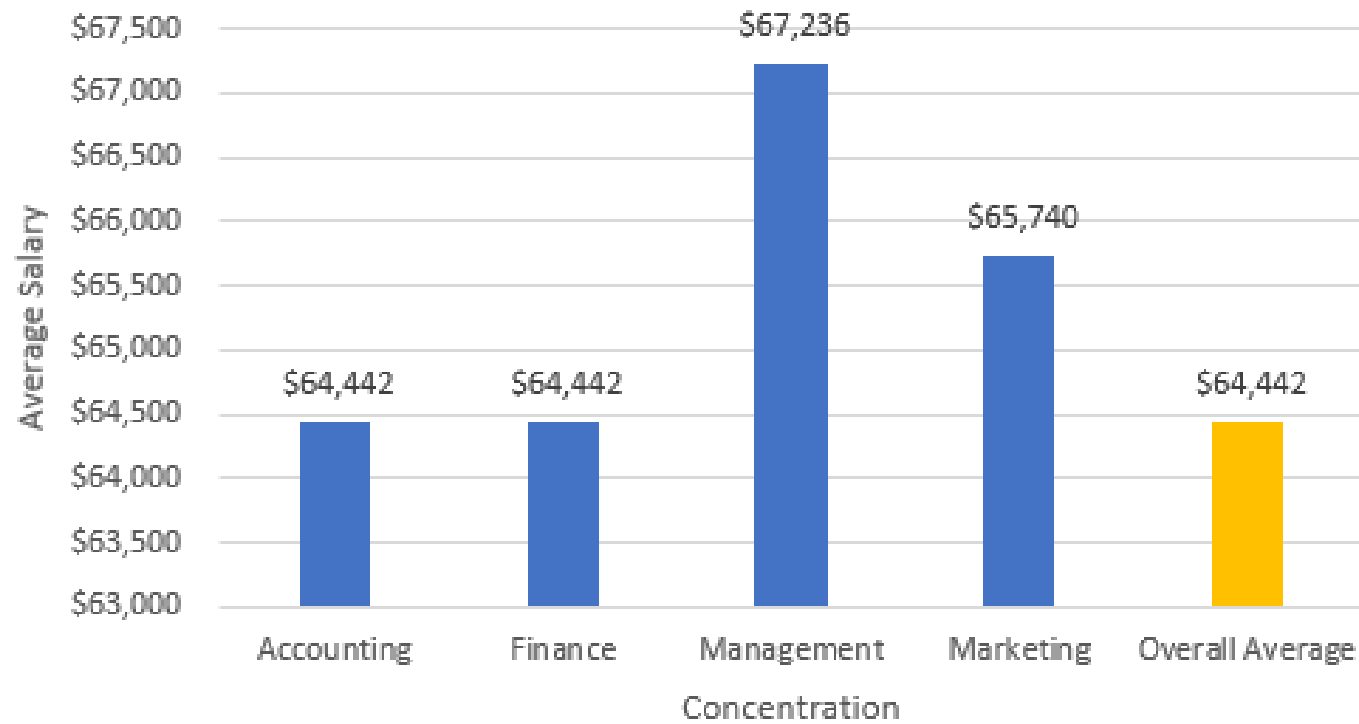
