


## History








## Average salaries one-year post-graduation by academic college:


# Average salaries one-year post-graduation by academic college for higher degrees:





MSU prepares you for a career with great pay and flexibility. 93.1% of students passed NCLEX on first attempt.







## Requirements & Prerequisites for Application

#### **Application Requirements**

- Minimum GPA of 3.0 in Nursing Prerequisites
- "C-" or better in Nursing Prerequisites
  - W/D/F are <u>not accepted</u>
  - No more than 2 retakes in prerequisites
- Completion of 3 of the required 5 sciences
  - One of which must be "Anatomy and Physiology I"
- Clinical Compliance Tracking / Drug Screening
