### 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Formal Admission/ Portfolio Review

- Students who wish to continue from the Foundations program into the B.A. in Environmental Design program will apply for formal admission at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> year (May)
- A student must have completed ARCH 121IA, ARCH 151RA, ARCH 152IA, M151Q or M171Q, and PHYX 205 during the 1<sup>st</sup> year (can include summer.)
- Criteria evaluated for Formal Admission:
  - At least a 2.7 overall GPA
  - 3.0 Architecture studio GPA (ARCH 151 and 152)
  - Portfolio (1<sup>st</sup> year studio work)
- Up to 78 qualified students are admitted to 2<sup>nd</sup> year
- 85-95% of students who apply to Formal Admission are accepted
- Students are then formally admitted for the next 3 years of the program
