Important Information for All School of Music Majors – Please Read Carefully

Your registration date is visible on DegreeWorks. Register as early as possible to get your courses.

If you brought AP/transfer/dual enrollment credits to MSU, please double-check DegreeWorks to make sure those classes are showing. If you have credits that are not showing on DegreeWorks, let me know during advising so that I can help you avoid taking unnecessary classes.

GPA Requirements:

- All Music Majors and Minors must pass all MUSI/MUSE/MUST with a C or better.
- Music Tech must pass all MUSI/MUSE/MUST, EELE 217 and FILM 259 with a C or better.
- Music Education must pass all MUSI/MUSE/MUST and education courses with a C or better.
- Music Education Admission to the Teacher Education Program (spring sophomore year) and student teaching require a 2.75 overall GPA, a 2.75 in any teaching major/minor/option, and a 2.75 content GPA in any teaching major/minor.
- Courses with prerequisites cannot be taken out of order.
- Courses with co-requisites cannot be taken in isolation.

Refer to the <u>online catalog</u> (or click a course you still need in DegreeWorks) to make sure you've met all prerequisites. If you think you have fulfilled a requirement and a substitution/exception needs to be made, please discuss with me during advising.

Double check that you are registering for the correct section of applied music (check with studio teacher), for correct ensemble(s) (check with directors), and for MSU Core that will fulfill BME, BA in Music, and Music Technology requirements.

If you have trouble registering for any MUSI, MUST, MUSE, EDU, FILM, or EELE course after your advising, please check with your advisor or area coordinator; They can help with restricted entry courses, transferred prerequisite courses, or other issues.

Double check your progress on concert attendance – 20 events per semester are required every semester of residency for the BME, BA in Music, and BA in Music Technology until you reach 160.
