*Field Training (FT): Cadets compete nationally to attend FT between their sophomore and junior year. FT is a 20-day summer encampment at Maxwell AFB, AL. Cadets are evaluated on their leadership potential. By completing FT, cadets join the Professional Officer Course.



What is Leadership Lab (LLAB)?

A 3-hour class held once per week. Cadets wear military uniforms or business casual attire and practice leadership skills, drill and ceremonies, and teamwork.

What is Physical Training (PT)?

Group workouts held twice per week to improve physical fitness. Workouts focus on cardio and calisthenics to prepare for the Air Force Fitness Test.

Does joining AFROTC require a military service obligation?

No, cadets do not incur a service obligation by joining AFROTC. For most freshmen and sophomores, remaining within the program is optional. Cadets "contract" at the beginning of their junior year or when activating a scholarship; once contracted, cadets may then incur a service obligation.

<u>Items to Bring to school:</u>

- Birth Certificate or Naturalization Certificate (If original unavailable, certified copy from the Clerk/Recorder of Birth State)
- Social Security Card signed by applicant
- Selective Service Number (Males only) (Bring card or screenshot for inprocessing: www.SSS.gov)
- □ All SAT and/or ACT test scores (Unofficial or official copies)
- Transcripts of all completed college work credited towards your undergraduate degree

What do I need to know before joining AFROTC at Montana State?

Business Casual Attire (Freshman uniform)

- Det 450 polo (purchase upon arrival, \$10) tucked in to slacks
- Khaki slacks
- Black or brown dress shoes
- Black or navy-blue socks
- Black or brown belt (match shoes)

Fitness Standards

✓ 1.5 mi run, 1 minute of push-ups, 1 minute of sit-ups



Military Grooming Standards

Ladies

- ✓ Hair pulled back (bun, ponytail, braid) OR shorter than collar length
- ✓ Only one earring per ear: small diamond, pearl, gold, silver spherical or square shape studs
- ✓ No other visible piercings

Gentlemen

- ✓ Clean shaven
- ✓ Hair will not touch ears, and will be tapered not to exceed 1/4"
- ✓ No visible piercings
