- Forum, Ambassador Fall Training..
- Represent the Montana 4-H program at state-wide events and speak on behalf of the Montana 4-H Program.
- Attend the State Ambassador Officer Fall and Spring Retreat
- Actively participate in monthly State Ambassador Officer Teleconference/video meetings.
- Other duties as agreed upon by the State Ambassador Officer and Advisor Team

## **Advisor Specific Responsibilities:**

- Coordinates training and development of State Ambassador Officers
- Assists the officers with defining and carrying out their duties

- Coordinates with 4-H Center advisor on details for lodging, meals, etc on team events
