Beef Tagging and Weigh-in

The event is on Saturday, December 28th at Noon at GaLor Genetics (8393 US Hwy 287, Townsend). To respect our host, please try to be on time and not too early. All market beef animals are required to attend. If you can't be there, you must make arrangements for your animal(s) to be there. Breeding animals are welcomed to get weighed but are not required to attend. It is recommended to bring your brand inspection paperwork for the inspector to look over and help provide guidance on what needs to be done prior to Fair. Also please be prepared to share information about your animal including breed, breeder and birthdate. DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that activities related to your 4-H project can also be done outside of the 4-H program?!

For example, if you are taking an art class in school, chances are that you are learning and making things that you could use for your 4-H project.

Townsend School's 5th day program also offers some art and pottery classes that can be used as learning experiences.

You do not have to attend a '4-H' workshop for it to be teaching you things regarding your project!

Watch STOKE's programming as well. They also offer classes for robotics, pottery and cooking!

Webinars from trustworthy and recognized sources of course can offer learning experiences that you may not be offered locally.

The most important part is to log these activities in your record books. Log the date, location, what you did and what you learned!

Re-Enrollment Reminders!

- ➤ Your 4-H age is calculated by how old you are on 10/1/2024 and does not change for the whole 4-H year!
- Years in 4-H are automatically updated in zsuites. When a member transitions from a Cloverbud to a traditional 4-H member, the years start over again at 1.
- Cloverbuds are members 4-H age 5-8. 'Cloverbuds' is the only project they can enroll in.
- Members who are 4-H age 8, can either be a Cloverbud or a traditional member.
- Members must be 4-H age 9 to enroll into Shooting Sports projects (except for BB Gun Safety).
- Members must be 4-H age 10 to enroll into Market Beef.
- For Market and Breeding livestock projects, the member must ALSO enroll into a project level for that species. (Ex. If you are enrolling into market swine you must add both 'Market Swine' AND 'Swine Level 1, 2, or 3'
- For DOG- You must enroll into a "Dog Level 1,2 or 3' project. IF you also want to do agility or obedience at Fair, you must also add 'Dog Agility' or 'Dog Obedience', or both.
- Project Books- please indicate in zsuites whether or not you need a project book. Check with your club leaders on how your club handles book orders. But zsuites is our back up for book lists, so please make it accurate. Rember the project level books are required, however the resource manuals are not.

Enrollment deadline is November 1st. At that point, only enrolled families will receive reminders and newsletters.
