EVENT HIGHLIGHTS

The goals of the 2024 Reimagining Rural Road Show are simple: Help rural communities recognize their potential by building capacity, increasing awareness and knowledge of resources available, expanding partnerships, and inspiring them to dream big. We know our rural communities are worth it.

The event will include inspirational success stories grounded in local resource partnerships. Local participants will have opportunities to make one-on-one or small group connections with resources, neighboring communities, and "rubber meets the road" options stocked with real-life scenarios and advice for our get-it-done volunteers.

Targeted attendees include nonprofit and organization volunteers, local leaders, government officials, business owners, and small-town entrepreneurs.

LONG TERM VISION

The long-term vision for the Reimagining Rural Road Show is to host one regional event annually. To kick off this project, the planning committee chose Miles City and southeastern Montana due to the high capacity of the regional communities. Specifically, many area communities have participated in Reimagining Rural, are members of the Montana Department of Commerce's Montana Main Street Program, have community foundations, and have successfully launched local, community-based leadership programs. At the event's conclusion, evaluation measures will be completed to determine future conferences. The planning committee will most likely utilize the input to plan the 2025 event in a different region. However, we also recognize that, at the conclusion, the participating communities may want to continue meeting/connecting in some capacity. If this outcome arises, we will assist these communities in determining a path forward to accomplish this.
