## COVID-19 RESPONSE Recommendations

- Full PPE including eye protection, N95 mask or SCBA, rubber gloves.
- Limit patient contact, assess from at least 6 feet away initially
- Sanitize all gear and apparatus on return
- Wash hands frequently
- Limit unnecessary contact at fire station
- If you are sick stay home
- If you have been around someone who has traveled stay home
- Reach out to neighboring departments and come up with a response plan in case your department starts to see a decrease in personnel due to being sick.
- Check your wildland masks, Hot shield masks have an N95 mask in them
- Maintain social distancing
- Avoid touching face
- Document all personnel that had contact with patients, what type of exposure, and how long. The more documentation the better!
- Treat everyone as if they have tested positive for COVID-19
