Learn the soil block method for starting transplants

BENEFITS OF THE SOIL BLOCK METHOD INCLUDE:

- More soil per start compared with a plug tray
- No root binding due to “air pruning”
- Easy transplanting - no struggling with containers, just lift the plants out like a piece of cake!
- Even water distribution
- Much less plastic waste and saves money
- Efficient spacing (50 blocks to a 1020 standard greenhouse tray measuring 11 x 12 inches)
