SAMPLE CONFERENCE/INTERVIEW JUDGING QUESTIONS

Every 4-H'er who is conference judged will be asked several questions. The conference may last only a few minutes for simple projects, or longer for more advanced work.

All conferences should consist of questions that:

- 1. Serve as an opening
- 2. Pursue in-depth knowledge
- 3. Look ahead into future 4-H work

SAMPLE QUESTIONS:

The judge will not ask all these questions, they will pick out the ones they feel will tell them how much you learned in your project.

General Conference Judging Questions:

(These can be used for all projects)

INTRODUCTION - -

- 1. Did you enjoy this project?
- 2. Have you taken this project before?
- 3. What did you like best about the project?
- 4. What other things did you make or do in this project during the year?

DETAILED LEARNING - -

- 1. How did you make this item? What steps were involved?
- 2. What were some of the problems you had in making this item?
- 3. What was the most fun you had doing when making this?
- 4. How much did it cost?
- 5. What did you learn from this project?
- 6. How do you plan to use this item?
- 7. Did you receive any help making your project?

CONTINUED LEARNING - -

- 1. Do you plan to take this project again?
- 2. What are some other things you could learn?
- 3. If you took this project again, what could you make for an exhibit that would be a challenge to you?
- 4. If you didn't like this project, what new project will you try next year?
